“REPRODUCTIVE RATE”:

- the average lifetime number of offspring produced by a member of a population,
- or the average number of offspring each adult is expected to produce.

“Replacement Fertility Rate”:

- 2.1 children
- simply replaces the population
- with no growth

“BELOW FERTILITY RATE”

- 2.1 is “Replacement Fertility Rate” - with no growth
- 53 developing nations are below that number.

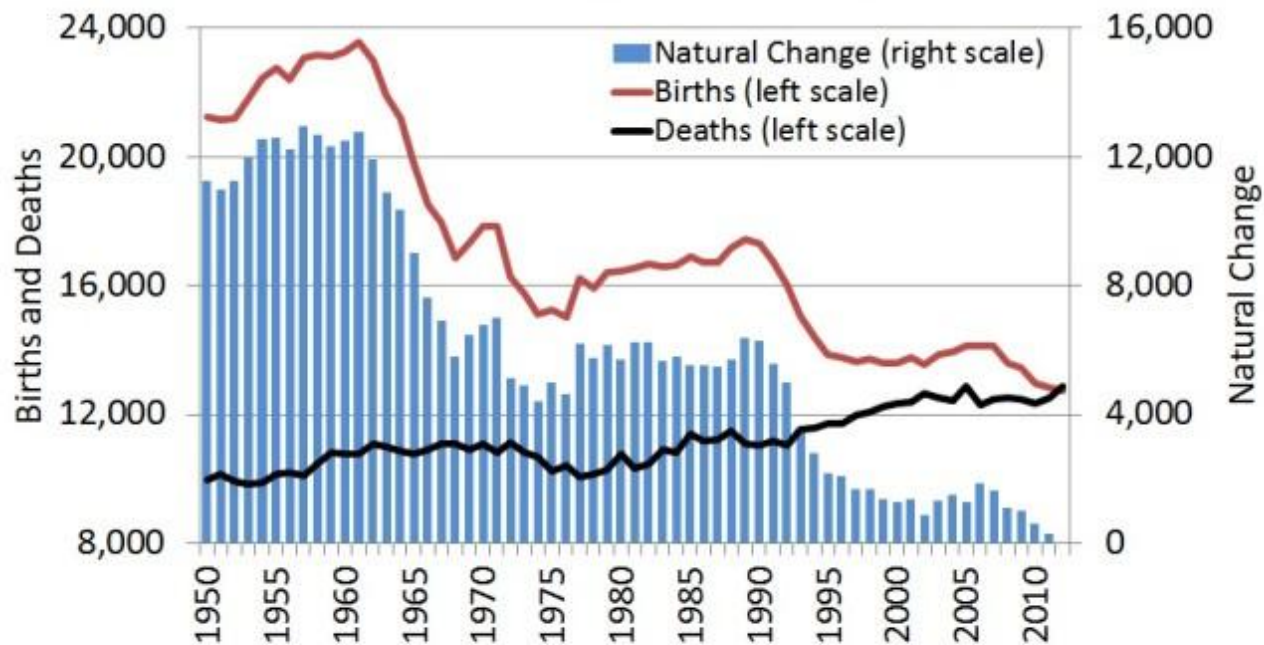
United States: 1.9 fertility rate

- The only reason we are that high is because of immigrants,

DEMOGRAPHIC WINTER

In 2012 we had no natural increase in population.
Without significant net in-migration our population is
likely to decline at an accelerating rate going forward.

(Natural change = births - deaths)

Russia: 1.4 Fertility Rate

- Every 25 years, Russia will lose 1/3 of its population
- By 2050 it will be an unsustainable culture and suffer irrevocable economic collapse
- China is probably even closer to this
- Europe and the United States are very close behind
