- 1:32 - Descending as a Dove - divine anointing. Descends and \_\_\_\_\_ on Jesus.
- 3:6; 6:63 - Giver of new \_\_\_\_\_
- 4:10; 7:38-39 - Living \_\_\_\_\_ (cf. Jer. 2:13; Ezek. 47:1-6; Zech. 14:8)
  - From the \_\_\_\_\_ the person of the Spirit flows

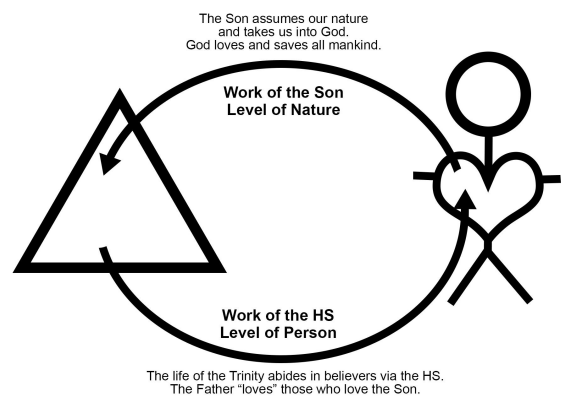
### The Promise of the Spirit (14:15-31)

- 16:16a - \_\_\_\_\_ "paraclete" who will never leave
- 14:17d - "With you" and "in you"
  - Jesus' promise to return (vv. 18, 20, 23, 28) - Jesus will be in them when the HS is "in them"
  - The HS is currently "with them" because Jesus is with them.

Jesus via the HS	HS via Jesus
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• "I will come to you" (v. 18)</li><li>• "I am in you" (v. 20)</li><li>• the Father and I will "come and make our home with" you (v. 23)</li><li>• "I will come back to you again" (v. 28)</li><li>• All this when He "will be in you" (v. 17d)</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• "He lives with you now" (v. 17d)<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ Begotten of the Father by the Spirit (Luke 1:35)</li><li>◦ The HS remained upon Jesus (1:32)</li></ul></li></ul>

- The \_\_\_\_\_ of each person in the Trinity is in the other
- Our salvation is a \_\_\_\_\_ salvation, in Jesus' name
  - V. 20 - same "in"ness
- Drawn into the divine \_\_\_\_\_ - v. 18 - "I will not leave you as orphans" (negative); \_\_\_\_\_ into the Family (positive)
  - The Spirit of adoption (Rom. 8:15)
  - By grace we become what Christ is by nature - Sons and daughters of God = "deification" (II Peter 1:3-4)

## The Commandments of Jesus

- V. 15 (cf. vv. 21, 23, 24a) - "If you love me, you will keep my commandments."
  - Summed up in 13:34 - if we love Jesus, we will love \_\_\_\_\_
  - Father is the \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 24b-c). HS \_\_\_\_\_ his commands (vv. 26, 17)
- The result of our love for one another and Jesus
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ love for us (vv. 21, 23)
    - God "loves" the whole world (3:16, et al.) - Jesus
    - God "loves" believers - HS
    - Love is always connected to the \_\_\_\_\_ of one's self.
    - World cannot \_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_ this reality (vv. 17b, 19, 27)
  - An element of \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 31; cf. 13:34-35)
    - It is a matter of \_\_\_\_\_
      - God's love \_\_\_\_\_ to himself flows from his love \_\_\_\_\_ to himself
      - God's love is \_\_\_\_\_: it desires to be shared
