## The effects of Pentecost: The Life of the Church

What is the evidence of the power and presence of the Holy Spirit in the church?

It was a \_\_\_\_\_ church - V. 42a - "They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching"

- What they were *not* doing:
  - Mystical experience  $\rightarrow$  despise the mind/disdain theology
  - Dispensing with human teachers
- What they were doing: Sitting at the apostles' feet, hungry to receive instruction
- V. 43b "many wonders and signs were taking place through the apostles"
  - Teaching \_\_\_\_\_\_ by miracles
    - Connection to Jesus' \_\_\_\_\_ & \_\_\_\_\_
- The \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God leads the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God to submit to the \_\_\_\_\_\_ of God

It was a \_\_\_\_\_\_ church - v. 42a - "They were continually devoting themselves to the...fellowship"

- Κοινωνία (koinonia) = "common"
  - What we share \_\_\_\_\_ together
    - The life of God himself Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (I John 1:3; II Cor. 13:14)
    - koinonia is a \_\_\_\_\_\_ experience
    - What we share \_\_\_\_\_ together what we give and receive
      - Paul's use of *koinonia* (II Cor. 8:4; 9:13)
      - Koinonikos = "\_\_\_\_" (cf. v. 45)
        - Not compulsory, but \_\_\_\_\_\_
        - Speaks to the \_\_\_\_\_ and
          - \_\_\_\_\_of the church
        - Cf. Dt. 26:12; I John 3:17
- It was a \_\_\_\_\_\_ church v. 42b "They were continually devoting themselves to the...breaking of bread and to prayer."
  - Definite article → Lord's Supper and prayer services/meeting
  - The \_\_\_\_\_ of worship
    - Formal and informal v. 46 "in the temple and...house to house"

- Did not abandon the "institution" of worship (cf. 3:1)
- Supplemented with informal, spontaneous meetings in homes
- Joyful and reverent v. 46 "with gladness and sincerity of hearts" and v. 43 "everyone kept feeling a sense of awe"
  - God had given gifts
  - God was also in their midst

# It was an \_\_\_\_\_ church

- Don't isolate v. 42! the \_\_\_\_\_\_ life of the church
- 47b "the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved"
  - The Holy Spirit is a \_\_\_\_\_ Spirit
  - The church filled with him is a \_\_\_\_\_ church
- 3 lessons to be learned about local church evangelism:
  - The Lord himself \_\_\_\_\_ (v. 47)
    - Guards against:
      - Pressure to assume the burden of changing people
      - Temptation to take credit
    - Evangelism = \_\_\_\_\_
  - Involves both the \_\_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ aspects of the church
    - "added to their number" people are drawn into the fellowship
    - "those who were being saved" those experiencing his salvation
  - It is an \_\_\_\_\_\_ activity "was adding day by day"
    - The verb tense + adverb \_\_\_\_ sporadic, occasion activity

### The Church's Relationships

- To the apostles \_\_\_\_\_
  - We are to be committed to the Word of God
- To one another \_
  - Fellowship, mutual support and care, sharing in and relieving each other's needs
- To God \_\_\_\_
  - In the temple, in the home, in the Lord's Supper, in the prayers, with joy and reverence
- To the world \_\_\_\_\_
  - Continuous evangelism, ongoing life of Spirit-enabled witness. No self-centered, self-contained, self-absorbed church.
