	<ul> <li>Light = truth and righteousness - 5:8b - "but now you are Light in the Lord; walk as</li> </ul>
	children of Light"
	<ul> <li>No preposition! Lit. you darkness, now you light</li> </ul>
	<ul><li>Lives vs. environment. Radical transformation "in the Lord"</li></ul>
	<ul><li>Our behavior must to our identity.</li></ul>

•	V. 9 - the fruit of this life of light is "all goodness and righteousness and truth"
	Like plants in nature, these things grow as the fruit of being in the Light of Christ
	V. 10 - "trying to learn what is pleasing to the Lord"
	Earnestly seeking to his Light
	V. 11 - "Do not participate in the unfruitful deeds of darkness, but instead even expose
	them"
	■ Negative: Do not participate in their "unfruitful deeds"
