- Peter's witness is reflected in Mark's gospel
 - Peter's relationship to Mark
 - Acts 12:12-14 Jerusalem house church
 - 1 Peter 5:13 "My son, Mark."
 - Mark/Peter seems parallel to Luke/Paul
 - Testimony of the early church (Papias, Irenaues, Justin, Clement, Tertullian, etc.)
 - Papias: "Mark became Peter's interpreter and wrote accurately all that he remembered, not, indeed, in order, of the things said and done by the Lord."
 - I Peter shows us what the story in Mark means for us as Jesus calls us to take up our cross and follow him.
