# **Deuteronomy Chapter 4.1–40**

### 4.1-8 Listen up!

- > Statutes or decrees are permanent <u>rules</u> of <u>conduct</u> from a superior. Rules or judgments are <u>judicial</u> decisions and <u>guidance</u>. Together they refer to all the Law of God.
- Teaching: Moses is a <u>prophet</u> and teacher. He is the <u>mediator</u> not the source of God's Law.
- The purpose of the God's Law is <u>life</u> in the land. It must be preserved from tampering either by adding to it or subtracting from it.
- ➤ Key theme in Deuteronomy: "Yahweh your God."
- ➤ LORD in all upper case in English translations of the Bible refers to <u>YHWH</u>, the name of God revealed to Israel.
- Receiving the Law of God is a privilege not a burden.

#### 4.9-14 Take Care!

- > Be on guard that you do not forget.
- Remember what you <u>saw</u> and <u>heard</u>.
- > "You saw no form! (4.12, 15).
- ➤ Remember the covenant the ten words or commandments.
- Remember for your whole life and your future generations.

### 4.15-24 Watch out for God is a Jealous God

- > Every form of idolatry is forbidden.
- > Every form of idolatry corrupts.
- > Every form of idolatry is offensive and violates the covenant.
- The land is your inheritance, but you are the Lord's <u>inheritance</u>.
- The Lord is a <u>consuming</u> fire and a <u>jealous</u> God (4.24).
- > Jealousy is not sinful weakness here, but is the "legitimate passion that is aroused when interference from a third party threatens a relationship, particularly a marriage relationship." (Daniel Block)
- The Lord deserves no rival and will not stand for any.

# 4.25–31 Judgment and Mercy

- ➤ 4.25 If you sin and worship idols . . . .
- ➤ 4.26–28 Then you will be judged as the nations were judged before you.
- ➤ 4.29–31 But "the Lord is a <u>merciful</u> God. He will not leave you or destroy you or forget the covenant with your fathers that he swore to them." (4.31)

# 4.32-40 The One and Only True God

- A unique <u>revelation</u>.
- A unique <u>salvation</u>.
- $\triangleright$  Yahweh is God and there is <u>no other</u>. (4.35, 39)
- Monotheism is the result of revelation not speculation.
- > There is no other God and the true God delivered a nation from bondage and gave them their own land as an inheritance.
- And he revealed himself to them by voice and <u>disciplined</u> them to <u>know</u> him as the only true God.
