- III. The Lord’s Requirements 10:12–11:1 Three Lists of Requirements
 - A. What does the Lord Require? 10:12,13
 1. Fear, Revere and live in awareness of his scrutiny and concern for what the Lord thinks of me and my behavior. Mat 10:28; Phil 2:12; Heb 4:1, 12:28,29
 2. Walk, Conduct yourselves in accordance with his will. “live in a way that pleases him” (NLT) John 8:12; rom 6:4, 8:3,4; Gal 5:16; Eph 2:10, 4:1–3, 17, 5:2, 8–10; IJohn 1:6,7
 3. Love, Allegiance, Commit yourselves to him alone above all things. (covenant loyalty and obedience flowing from gratitude) Matt. 22:36-38; John. 14:15, 21:15; Rom 8:28
 4. Serve, Worship Act in accordance with this will and purposes (bonded service to the one who bought them) Mat 6:24; Luke 4:8; Rom 1:9, 12:11; 2 Tim. 1:2-3
 5. Keep, Obedience. Obey his law and live in accordance with it. “Careful, conscientious and constant attention to the terms and stipulations of the covenant relationship” Christopher Wright :ile 11”28; John 8:55, 14:15, 23,24, 15:10; ITim 6:13,14; IJohn 2:3–6; Rev 1:3, 12:17, 14:12, 22:9
 - B. Requirements Part 2: 10:19,20
 1. Love the Sojourner based on who the Lord is
 2. Fear

3. Serve
4. Hold Fast (cling or cleave to) cf 4:4, 11:22; 13:4; 30:20
5. Swear, make oaths in his name only. Bind oneself with an oath = give sacred, unbreakable word to faithfully perform some promised deed or refrain from some evil act.

A. The Owner God–Creator and Ruler of all.

B. The Loving God–chose you above all people on earth.

C. The Warrior God–Great, mighty, awesome.

D. The Just, Impartial God.

E. The Generous God–loves the sojourner and gives food.

F. The Almighty God–Done great and terrifying things.
